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Danger Level 1 - Low



In the highest altitudes of the High Tatras (above 2000 m above sea level) there is a SMALL avalanche danger, 1st degree

Only isolated avalanches from wet snow are possible.

Snowpack

The snow cover is more continuous only in the highest altitudes of the Tatra Mountains, usually above 2000 m above sea level and especially in terrain depressions, in troughs and in the valleys of the Tatra valleys. The snow is frozen in the morning and turns very wet during the day. Its height decreases significantly day by day.

Tendency

gradually decreasing day by day
